Jeremy Moore / Lanny Stucky moved to approve the minutes from the regular meeting of April 3, 2017. Passed 4 Ayes, 0 Nays.

Kent Winsky / Kevin Schmidt moved to approve the April bills. Passed 4 Ayes, 0 Nays.

Mayor Fisher opened the meeting to the public; Lory Fisher from the Moundridge Arts Council requested the City install a street light in the 100 block of S. Randall.
