COUNCIL MINUTES

REGULAR MEETING 05/07/18

Mayor Fisher called the meeting to order at 5:45 and lead the pledge of Allegiance. In attendance were Council members – Kirk Stucky, Gib Burgan, Kevin Schmidt, and Jeremy Moore.

- Kirk Stucky / Gib Burgan moved to approve the minutes April 2, 2018 regular meeting. Passed 4 Ayes, 0 Nays.
- Kirk Stucky / Jeremy Moore moved to approve the minutes April 16, 2018 special meeting. Passed 4 Ayes, 0 Nays.
- Kevin Schmidt / Gib Burgan moved to approve the March bills. Passed 4 Ayes 0 Nays
- Mayor Fisher opened the meeting to public; Stephan Owens, candidate for Kansas House of Representatives for the 74TH district introduced himself. Jamie Snyder shared her concerns with the safety of pedestrians crossing streets around the Cole and Wildcat Drive area. With no other public comments Mayor Fisher moved on to the next agenda item.
- Street and Waste Water Superintendent Mike Strausz addressed the council about the lease on the Bobcat mini excavator. He received an email that it would expire May 11th. Council directed staff to get information on purchasing this equipment and they would have a special meeting to consider it.
- Mayor Fisher opened the Public Hearing to consider if the two structures located at 322 W. Hirschler Street, Moundridge, Kansas are dangerous, unsafe or unfit for human habitation and should be condemned. City Administrator informed the council that there is a signed agreement in place to sell the property, and would like the hearing to be continued until the June meeting to give this a chance to be work out. Kevin Schmidt / Gib Burgan moved to continue the hearing until the June 6th meeting. Passed 4 Ayes 0 Nays.

- Kevin Schmidt / Kirk Stucky move to approve Ordinance No. 968 - An Ordinance Establishing a Land Bank in Conformance with K.S.A. 12-5901 Et Seq., Within the City of Moundridge, Kansas. Passed 4 Ayes 0 Nays.
- City Administrator Randy Frazer didn't have a need for the Executive Session agenda item at this time, Mayor Fisher moved on to the next agenda item.
