COUNCIL MINUTES

REGULAR MEETING 07/02/18

Mayor Fisher called the meeting to order at 5:45 and lead the pledge of Allegiance. In attendance were Council members – Kirk Stucky, Kevin Schmidt, Kent Winsky, and Jeremy Moore.

- Kirk Stucky / Kevin Schmidt moved to approve the minutes June 4, 2018 regular meeting. Passed 4 Ayes, 0 Nays.
- Jeremy Moore / Kent Winsky moved to approve the June bills. Passed 4 Ayes 0 Nays
- Mayor Fisher opened the meeting to public; With no public comments Mayor Fisher moved on to the next agenda item.
- Mayor Fisher opened the Public Hearing to consider if the two structures located at 322 W. Hirschler Street, Moundridge, Kansas are dangerous, unsafe or unfit for human habitation and should be condemned. City Administrator informed the council that the property sold on June 20th which ended this condemnation process. Kevin Schmidt / Jeremy Moore moved to end the condemnation process on this property. Passed 4 Ayes 0 Nays.
- John Waltner with REAP (Regional Economic Area Partnership) thanked the council for being members and for participating in the organization. He gave a brief overview of the history and purpose of REAP as well as issues that REAP will be working on.
- It was council consensus to reimburse moving expenses up to \$1000.00. The city Administrator will work on a formal policy for the council to consider at a future meeting.
- Jeremy Moore / Kirk Stucky move to approve KDHE Revolving Loan Pay request #3 in the amount of \$196,119.13. Passed 4 Ayes 0 Nays.

- Economic Development Director Murray McGee presented his monthly report and answered questions from the council.
- Police Chief Jay Kessler and Captain Mike Sparks reported on the first half of this year's crime statistics and answered questions from the council
- City Administrator Randy Frazer presented his monthly report and answered questions from the council.
